## How to get to the Airport?

It's not part of the regular public transport system! But you can get there either by water with [ALILAGUNA](#) OR by **regular bus** from Piazzale Roma. Full details are provided below.

<b>ALILAGUNA Venice &lt;---&gt; Airport</b>	one way: 18 €	round trip: 32 €
<b>ALILAGUNA (Murano &lt;---&gt; Airport)</b>	one way: 10 €	round trip: 18 €
<b>BUS (Piazzale Roma &lt;---&gt; Airport)</b>	one way: 10 €	round trip: 18 €

# BEST LINES BY ACTV WATER-BUS

**LINE 1:** goes all along the Grand Canal from Piazzale Roma to Lido Island (beach). It's pretty long since does all the stops but panoramic either.

**LINE 2:** goes all along the Grand Canal from Tronchetto to Lido (just on summer), faster because it does just main stops. It goes also to San Giorgio Maggiore island and Giudecca island.

**LINE 5.1, 5.2 AND 6:** outer lagoon routes running along the city's outer edges (they don't travel through the Grand Canal!) Line 5 operate full circular route in opposite directions.

**LINE 3:** from Piazzale Roma / Ferrovia to Murano

**LINE 12:** from Fondamente Nove to Murano, Burano and Torcello.

Anyway, using the **app CHEBATEO?** you won't have any problem!



# GONDOLA

**WHERE TO TAKE IT?** The most scenic areas are around Rialto or Dorsoduro and the quieter canals near the city center. AVOID very crowded stations such as Bacino San Marco and Bacino Orseolo where there can be heavy boat traffic, waves, and large tour groups. Don't queue up.

**CHOOSE YOUR GONDOLIER** - Don't book online! You don't need a reservation. Simply approach a gondolier you feel comfortable with: a friendly attitude makes a difference.

**OFFICIAL PRICE** - the standard daytime is 90€ for 30 minutes (up to 5 people per gondola) after sunset is 110 €.

**SINGING NOT INCLUDED** - Gondoliers do not automatically sing. Serenades are an extra service.

**PAY AFTER THE TOUR** - if they ask you to pay before don't go.

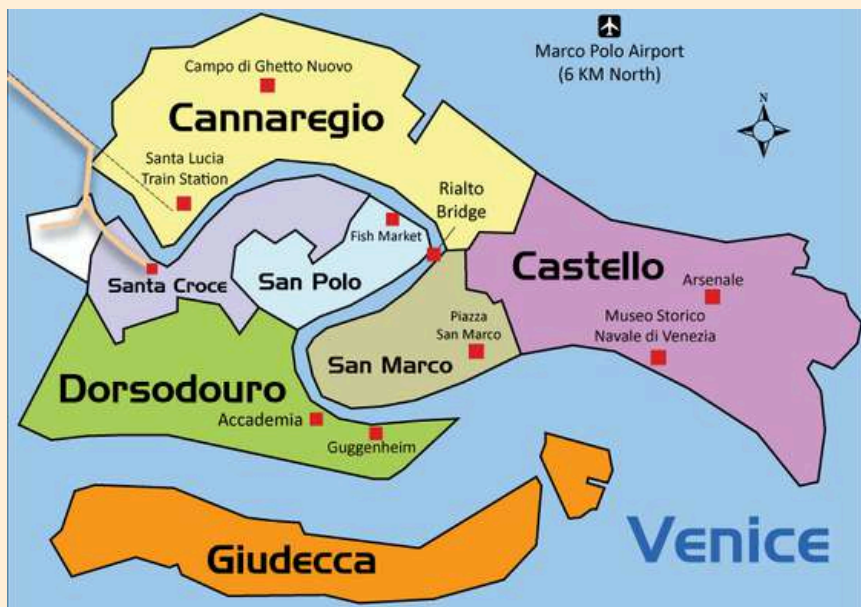


# SHOPPING

In Venice credit card is not accepted everywhere, so **if you need cash:**

- **Don't withdraw** money from the blue-yellow **ATM's Euronet** that are literally everywhere (high commissions / clone cards!)
- Do not use currency exchange services at Rialto/San Marco/Strada Nuova. Crazy commissions!
- ATM: **look for** the **BANCOMAT** symbol. You will only pay your bank's fee and exchange rate is more favorable.
- **Murano Glass:** best place to buy is Murano but not always assumed. In Dorsoduro there are nice artisanal shops. Be sure to find the "made in Murano" sticker, **ask for WARRANTY**, don't be afraid to bother the clerck.
- **Carnival Masks:** choose shops that sell only handmade Venetian papier-mâché masks clearly marked as made in Venice. Best are in **hidden workshops in the backstreets** where you can see the artisan at work. From 25€ and up.

**SAN MARCO:** St. Mark's Square, Museo Correr, church of **San Salvador**, Museo **Fortuny**, Palazzo **Contarini del Bovolo**, Teatro la Fenice

**DORSODURO:** **Gallerie dell'Accademia**, Peggy Guggenheim collection, church of **Santa Maria della Salute**, Punta della Dogana, **Squero San Trovaso**, Ponte dei Pugni, Campo Santa Margherita

**SAN POLO:** **Scuola Grande di San Rocco** (Venice Sistine's chapel!), church of **Frari**, Rialto market, Rialto Bridge, Ponte delle tette

**SANTA CROCE:** church of **San Giacomo dell'Orio**, Ca' Pesaro, Museo scienze naturali, **Palazzo Mocenigo**
